The RQRM launches a call for applications for training awards

The RQRM Steering Committee announces a **Call for applications for Training Awards covering a portion of the SSM11 registration fee**. The Committee has created 10 scholarships worth \$200 each for students enrolled in a university program (bachelor, Master's, PhD level) and working in the laboratory of a regular member of the RQRM.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The supervisor must be a member of the RQRM or have applied for membership at the time of submission.
- Participants must be enrolled in a university program* at a Quebec university.
- Research supervisors must be researchers, as recognized by the FRQS or NSERC.
- This award is not to be combined with any other award (for example, the GRUM award for SSM11).
- A maximum of one award will be awarded per supervisor per competition. The accumulation of awards is not permitted.

** Eligibility is now open to undergraduate students who complete a research internship in the laboratory of a member of the RQRM in the summer 2019.*

- Candidate's complete resume, including his most recent transcript
- Short abstract of the research project (100 words) **
- Letter of motivation (1/2 page) **
